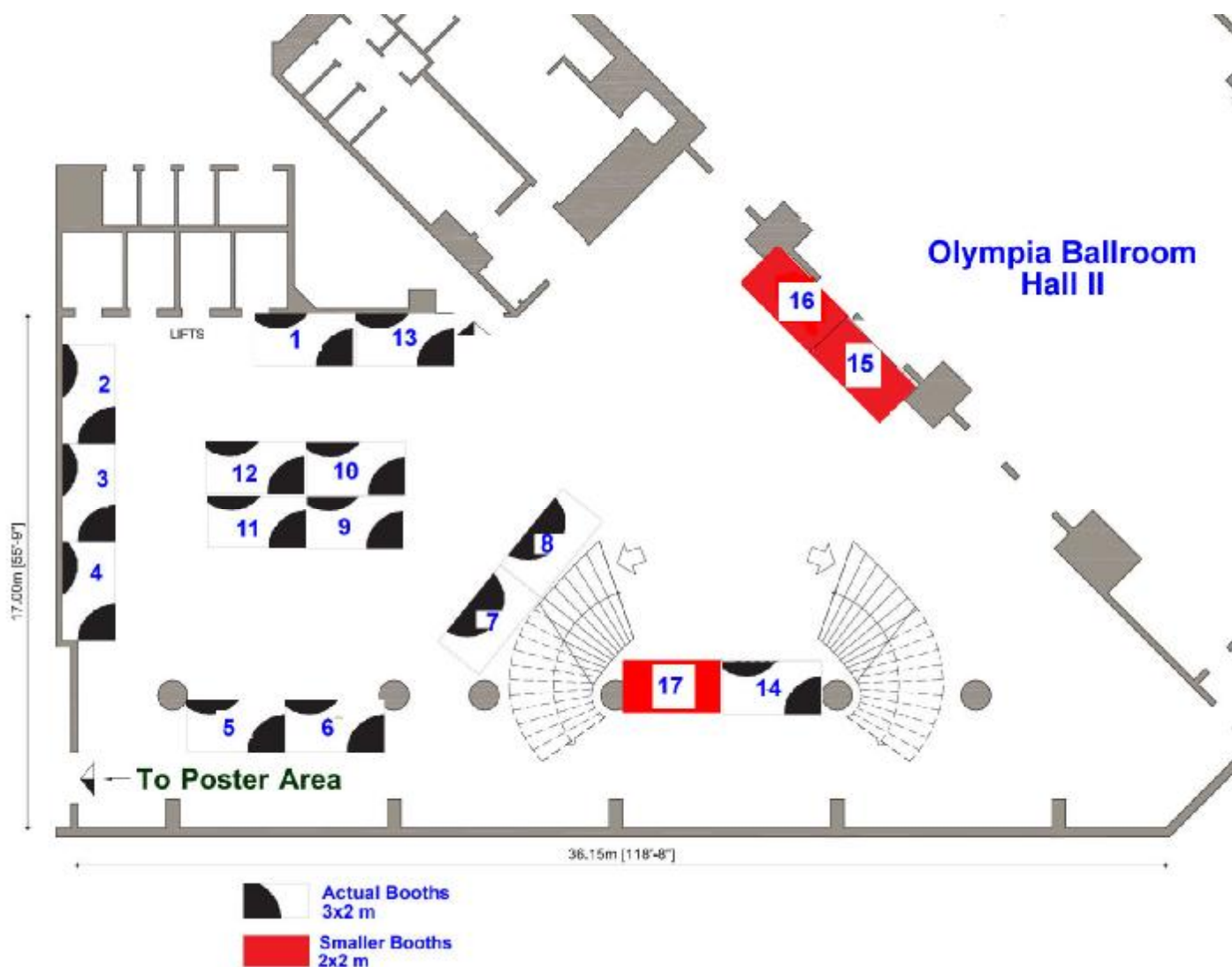

- Before 1st February 2009: 50% of the total due will be refunded
- On or after 1st February 2009: No refund available
